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The course can be simplified in this way. Students are asked to do the following:

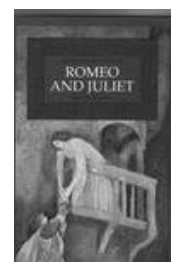
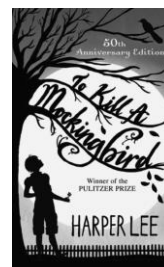
1. Read for three hours every week
